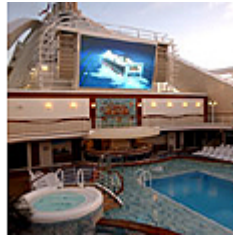


Caribbean Princess

Personal Choice – Coral Dining Room & Palm Dining Room

Specialty – Sabatini's Italian Trattoria & Sterling Steakhouse

Casual - 24-hour dining in the Horizon Court, Café Caribe, Wine and caviar bar, Patisserie, Prego Pizzeria, Trident Hamburger Grill, Ice Cream bar, 24-hour complimentary room service.

Dress Code: Varies from Casual to Formal depending on length of cruise.

Smart Casual Evenings:

Passengers dress as they would for a fine restaurant at home.

- Skirts/dresses, slacks, and sweaters for ladies
- Pants and open-neck shirts for men

In the dining room, items such as cutoff T-shirts, shorts, halter tops, and jeans are not permitted; shoes must be worn at all times.

Formal Evenings:

- Evening gowns and cocktail dresses for ladies
- Tuxedo, slacks with dinner jackets, or suits for men

Princess offers formal wear rental on all cruises; this can be arranged prior to embarkation.

Gratuities

During your cruise, you will meet our staff in a variety of locations who provide you with excellent service. Many more crew support those who serve you directly. For your convenience a discretionary Hotel and Dining charge of \$10 per passenger per day (including children) will be added to your shipboard account on a daily basis. This charge will be shared amongst those staff who help provide and support your cruise experience, including the wait staff, stateroom stewards, buffet stewards, galley staff, laundry staff and others. Please note this is a discretionary charge and should you wish to remove or make any adjustments, you may do so by contacting the Passenger Services Desk onboard.

Casino dealers and Lotus Spa personnel do not share in the Hotel and Dining charge as not all passengers utilize these services.

Bar and Wine Service Charge

A 15% service charge is added to bar charges and dining room wine account. This is shared amongst the beverage staff and their support staff, including cleaners and utility staff. Princess feels certain you will find the services onboard exemplary.
