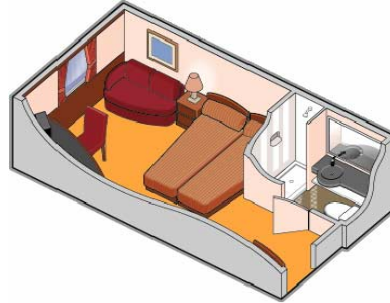

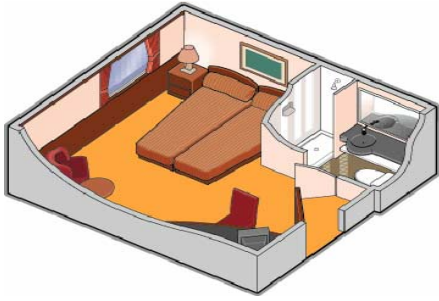

**Deluxe Ocean-view Stateroom aprox. 160 square feet. Category XD**



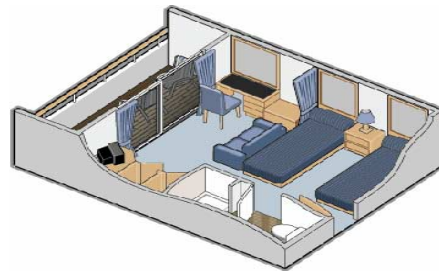
**Features:** Convertible double or single beds, sea-view portholes and sitting area.

On the Celebrity Expedition you have several dining options, including the main dining room at Darwin's Restaurant, selections served on deck throughout the day at the Beagle Grill, or complimentary rooms service.

### **Darwin's Restaurant**

Located on the Marina Deck, Darwin's Restaurant is where you'll discover culinary wonders that are sure to dazzle the palate as well as please the eye. Crisp white linen, fine crystal and exemplary service make dining amongst the islands as special and memorable as the islands themselves.

### **Beagle Grill**

### **Special Dietary Requirements**

## **Clothing**

While sailing aboard the Xpedition guests will require two types of clothing. Casual Explorers Day Wear and Casual Evening Wear.

**Casual Explorers Day Wear** – lightweight, comfortable clothing suited for walking/hiking. This includes;

- Lightweight or cotton pants and shorts
- Lightweight short-sleeved and long-sleeved shirts such as polo shirts and cotton t-shirts, lightweight rain jacket/wind breaker, and sweatshirts
- Comfortable walking shoes or lightweight hiking boots, and waterproof sandals for wet landings
- Two or more bathing suites, as well as extra sunblock, sun hats, sunglasses and other types of sun protection.

**Casual Evening Wear**

For ladies this includes;

- Casual dress or skirt
- Blouse or pants outfit
- Sweaters, jackets/windbreakers should be packed.

For men this includes;

- Slacks or pants
- Dress shirt
- Polo or collared shirt
- Sweaters, jackets/windbreakers should be packed.

**Gratuity Policies** – Included in the fare are gratuities to shipboard staff, lecturers, as well as gratuities for the naturalist guides. Also included are beverages including house wine, champagne, liquor, beer and soda.
