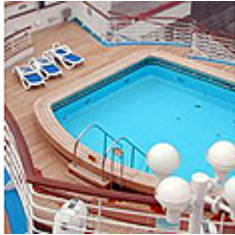


Crown Princess

Casino dealers and Lotus Spa personnel do not share in the Hotel and Dining charge as not all passengers utilize these services.

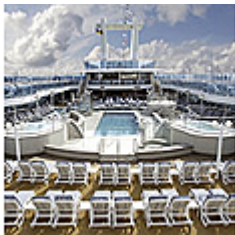
Bar and Wine Service Charge

Coral Princess



The Coral Princess is one of the most advanced passenger vessels afloat, offering the same vast public room space as Princess' larger ships.
