Internet access is available in the Library 24 hours a day until 8am the day of debarkation.

Pricing: Oceania offers 4 different rate packages, which include the following:

- \$.95/minute with no package
- 100 minutes for \$80. Extra minutes are \$.80/minute
- 200 minutes for \$140. Extra minutes are \$.70/minute
- 500 minutes for \$300. Extra minutes are \$.60/minute

Package amounts are charged upfront and no refunds will be made for unused minutes. All additional minutes are charged at the same rate level.

In Cabin Service: Dial in access is available from your stateroom, enabling your laptop to have Internet access. This service is available for a \$25 set-up fee plus any applicable per minute charges. Minutes listed above.

Courses: Lectures are presented occasionally throughout the cruise in the Lounge. Watch Oceania Currents for the dates and times. Topics may include the Internet and World Wide Web, surfing the World Wide Web, and interesting Things You Can Do With a PC.

All classes are conducted in small groups and are presented throughout the cruise in the Oceania@Sea Room.
