Seabourn Suites. Category A – A3 aprox. 277 square feet.

Seabourn Balcony Suites. Category B2-B3 aprox 277 square feet.

Double Suites. Category D1 aprox. 554 square feet.

Consists of two Category A1 suites combined. Classic Suites. Category CS aprox. 400 square feet

DINING INFORMATION

Skilled at the art of a la minute preparation and playful aesthetic presentation Seabourn chefs transform fresh seasonal ingredients into culinary masterpieces. Whether you prefer innovative cuisine, classic dishes or lighter fare, relish an odyssey of taste to match the adventure of your voyage. One of the creative forces behind Seabourn's exceptional gourmet cuisine is celebrity chef Charlie Palmer. His progressive approach to American cuisine is showcased in a wide variety of specially created signature dishes.

In the stylish open-seating Restaurant, tables glisten with Porsgrund china and Schott Zwiesel crystal. Candlelit evenings are elegant occasions, often with dancing. On *black-tie-optional* evenings, tuxedos sequins add to the sparkle. Most evenings, however, are simply "jacket required".

As a delightful alternative option, the Veranda Café, has seating either inside or out on the teak deck. Here they present delicious fare served on contemporary Rosenthal china. There are fresh breakfast and lunch buffets, with waiters to assist you. Nightly, the café provides a more casual *by-reservation-only* alternative to The Restaurant, featuring a fusion of contemporary flavors and culinary specialties of the chef.

On sea days opt for a barbecue lunch at the Sky Grill on deck. And don't miss the signature *Evening Under the Stars*, complete with dinner, lively music and dancing in the moonlight.
